The Nebraska Nut Growers Association (**NeNGA**) annually conducts a **Nut Evaluation** to increase our knowledge of known nut cultivars and to identify new, high producing, high quality nut trees. Typical species for evaluation include: Black Walnut, Pecan, Hickory, Butternut, Persian Walnut, Hazelnut and Heartnut, but other species will be accepted and evaluated. You can make copies for additional nut entries. **RULES:**

- 1. An entry consists of 10-15 nuts (no limit on number of entries).
- 2. Nuts must be clean. Remove all hulls and wash the nuts and allow to air dry for about two to three weeks. Crack a few samples to make sure the nut meat is dry. A steel brush works well to remove residue. Use of potato peelers on nut entry prohibited.
- 3. A "NeNGA Nut Evaluation Entry" must accompany each entry (copies can be made of this form).
